From 1991 to 1994 complete my field work in the largest island of the Guadalquivir (Seville) In addition to start my participation in the Working Group for the Study of the socio-cultural identities in Andalusia. From 1992 to 1998 I was a member of the research team on Formation, reproduction and the transformations of the Social Identities in Andalusia. My research on gender include the participation in the project "The role of immigrant women in the development of their places of origin: the case of the Moroccan and Ecuadorian", "Flemish Women: ethnicity, education and power before the new professional challenges" "Work Cultures, management models and levels of satisfaction of the employees Cubans and their Spanish companies in the tourism sector in Cuba" and "relational dependencies in the couple and the child abuse" as well as in a project of Excellence in Teaching, theon the twenty-first century to promote the coeducation in the school environment. With regard to artistic processes I have published two books of compilation of the artisans of andas and carvings of the Holy Week, articles on musical creativity and the role of women in the flamenco in addition to collaborating with artists such as Pilar Albarracín. In 2005 develop a work funded by the Ministry of Culture on the collection dispersed the photographic material. I was a member of the jury of the National Contest of Popular Photography Center of Ethnological Heritage Research and international co-ordinator in the equal Project for the development of stories of life among women of Andalusia, Carcassone and Emilia Romagna in Italy.
